

Notice of Availability of Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment Report

Notice is hereby given that the City of Tucson, partnering with the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), has made available the Tucson Urban Corridor Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment report for public review and comment. This project will implement a modern streetcar line that connects major activity centers in the central core, including downtown Tucson, the Downtown Redevelopment area, the 4th Avenue and Main Gate business districts, The University of Arizona, and the Arizona Health Sciences Center. Local funding for this project was approved as part of the RTA vote in May 2006.
