### **RTA INVITES PUBLIC TO SUN SHUTTLE OPEN HOUSES**

#### **Learn about proposed changes to Sun Shuttle service**

**TUCSON, Ariz.** – The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) is conducting open house events to inform the public and obtain feedback about proposed changes to Sun Shuttle Routes 420 and 425 serving Sahuarita and Green Valley, Route 412 serving Marana, and Route 402 serving Oro Valley. Funded by the RTA and launched in May 2009, Sun Shuttle provides neighborhood transportation and connections to Sun Tran service in Marana, Oro Valley, Catalina, Sahuarita, Green Valley, San Xavier and Tucson Estates.

The open house events will take place at the following locations:

- Marana – Monday, March 22, 5:30 – 7 p.m., Heritage Highlands Clubhouse – Catalina II Room, 4949 West Heritage Club Boulevard.
- Green Valley – Tuesday, March 23, 9 – 11 a.m., Green Valley Village, Suite 13, 101-26 South La Canada Drive.
