This meeting is open to the public. The following is an agenda of the matters to be considered, discussed, and acted upon. The sequence of the agenda may be changed by order of the Committee.

Agenda

1. Call to Order and Roll Call
2. Approval of Minutes of November 16, 2005
3. Status of the RTA twenty-year comprehensive regional transportation plan
The RTA Executive Director will update the Committee on the status of the twenty-year comprehensive Regional Transportation Plan. This will include an update on the recent actions of the RTA Board, and the jurisdictional review of the draft plan.
4. Implementation of Safety and Environmental/Economic Vitality elements
The Committee will discuss details and provide direction regarding the implementation of items contained within the Safety and Environmental Enhancement categorical elements of the proposed draft comprehensive Regional Transportation Plan. The Safety element includes intersection improvements, elderly/pedestrian safety improvements, bus pullouts, at-grade railroad safety and deficient/unsafe bridge improvements, and signalization technology. The Environmental/Economic Vitality element includes greenways/pathways/bikeways/sidewalks, transportation-related critical wildlife linkages, and small business assistance.
5. Implementation of RTA Plan
The Committee will discuss recent policies adopted by the RTA Board concerning implementation of the RTA plan. This will also include a discussion on coordination with the local jurisdictions, and related procedures that might be necessary to facilitate implementation.
6. Future of the Technical/Management Committee
The Chair, Committee members and RTA staff will discuss whether additional work of the Committee is necessary.

7. Call to the audience

The public will have the opportunity to speak before the Committee. Speakers are limited to a three-minute oral presentation and may submit written comments of any length for the Committee's files. Those wishing to address the Committee should complete a Citizen Information Card prior to the meeting being called to order specifying the topic to be addressed. Individual Committee Members may respond to criticism made by those individuals who have addressed the Committee and may ask staff to review a matter and place it on a future agenda. However, the Committee will not discuss or take action on a matter raised during a call to the Audience/Public that is not already on the agenda.

8. Adjournment
